

Windsurfing

Windsurfing is a naturally younger brother of surfing - the history of the board with a sail is much shorter than surfing. To this day it is not clear who invented windsurfing and first joined the board with a sail. The popular argument is that the idea came Darby, and his idea was later improved by the Drake and Schweitzer.

Windsurfing is swimming on a board with a sail. Depending on the conditions used for different sizes of boards and thrusters. At a higher level of surfing, with stronger winds, in order to relieve the hands are used so. trapezoid.
